

Admissions Appeals Process

You have the right of appeal to an independent appeals panel if you are refused a Reception place at St Mary's CE Primary School.

Process and timeline:

- Please consult the School Admission Appeals section on the Haringey Council website
 AND complete the appropriate online form, by 21st May 2021.
 https://www.haringey.gov.uk/children-and-families/schools-and-education/school-admissions/appeals
- The independent appeals administrator will contact you after the deadline to let you
 know when your appeal will take place. You will be given at least 20 school days from
 the date of notification that you application was unsuccessful to the appeal hearing. All
 appeals will be held online.
- You will receive at least 10 school days' notice of your appeal hearing, which will be clerked by an external independent appeal clerk.
- The independent appeal panel will hear your appeal and their decision is binding.
- The panel decision will be communicated to you via letter within five school days of the hearing wherever possible.
- Any Reception appeals received before 21 May 2021 will be considered as on-time.
 You will be contacted at least 10 days before the hearing to confirm the date of your appeal.
- Any Reception appeals received after 21 May 2021 will be considered as late and may be heard after those appeals which were submitted on-time. Late appeals may be heard in Autumn 2021.

Reception Appeal Dates

Appeals received by 21 May 2021 will be heard on the dates shown below. These dates are subject to change, but changes are likely to be minimal if any. All appeals will be heard online. The independent appeals administrator will contact you to let you know exactly when your appeal will take place.
