Summer 1 - Do cows drink milk?

This topic explores farm animals, the foods they eat, farm machinery and farm produce. The children will learn about the life cycle of a duck, whilst the eggs are incubated in class. It also compares the similarities and differences between country and city life.

Spring 2 - What can you see in summer?

This topic explores the things that are associated with summer, including the different flowers we might see in the local area, the type of fruits that will grow for us to enjoy, and the food we might eat. We will be exploring what temperatures we might experience and clothing we might wear.
