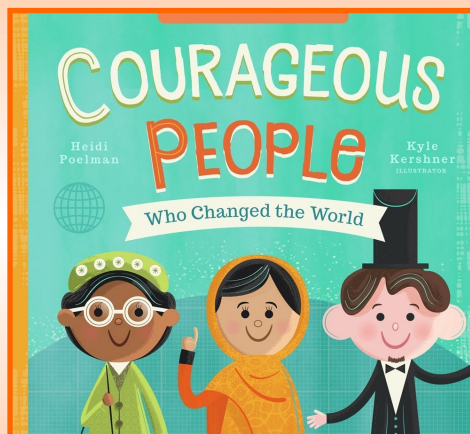
## English
