

Destination Reader

Whole class exploration of a text with the focus on developing the following reading skills and strategies:

- Predicting, Asking questions, Clarifying, Summarising, Inferring, Evaluating, and Making Connections.
- Our aim is to enable our children to develop good reading habits, positive learning behaviours and become confident and independent readers.
- Guided reading sessions with a focus on further promoting the DR skill/strategy taught that week
- It is very important for your child/children to read every day at home as this will expand their vocabulary and give them the tools to be successful writers.



Maths

- Our ambition is that all pupils become confident and fluent in the fundamentals of mathematics.
- There is a strong focus on an understanding of mathematical language as well as encouraging children to explain their mathematical thinking through problem solving and reasoning.
- In Maths this term we will be looking at the place value of numbers, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Focus on building number facts learnt and to develop times tables.
- Instant interventions to close gaps will take place in class time.
