# **Saffron and Tangerine Classes**

#### Welcome back

Happy New Year and we hope that you all had an enjoyable festive break. A huge thanks for all the lovely Christmas treats.

### **Curriculum**

#### Maths

Through investigations and using hands on manipulatives, we will focus on improving our reading, writing, ordering and place value of numbers to 50. We will also look at weight, height, length and volume through hands on investigations and problem solving as well as counting in 10s.

### **English**

We will focus on strengthening our phonics and reading knowledge, as well as investigating all the high frequency words. We will continue our Talk for Writing programme by looking at stories such as Grandad's Island by Benji Davies & My Pet T-Rex by Fabi Santiago, which tie in well with our topic. We will also focus on letter formation and writing sentences using capital letters, a variety of punctuation, adjectives, plurals and suffixes.

#### Science

We will be investigating the human body organs and bones of the skeleton through videos and stories and linking this to RSHE topics of human life cycles, changes in me since a baby, and female and male body parts. Also, we will be comparing and classifying animals and investigating seasonal changes: Winter to Spring.

## **Humanities (History & Geography)**

Our first topic is 'Childhood,' through which we will investigate where our family come from and how life and toys have changed through time. After half term, we will investigate the lives of dinosaurs – what they were, where they lived, and how they became extinct.

## **Enrichment (Art, Music & PE)**

In art & DT, we will be exploring observational drawing techniques and paper sculpture via investigating many different artists. In music, we will be singing many different songs from different cultures and learning more about notes and pitch. In PE, we will be focusing on gymnastics with elements of dance.

# **Religious Education**

We will investigate Hinduism and The Easter Story. We will explore Hindu artefacts, stories relating to their festivals, as well as Hindu gods and place of worship. We will explore the Easter story and why it is the most important Christian festival through 'Godly Play', art and videos, ensuring that our school vision, Christian values and spirituality are embedded through our learning.

#### Homework

Please support your child's learning at home by reading with them daily and practising their phonic sounds and high frequency words. Also, you can help improve your child's writing by writing their own sentences, creating stories or shopping lists. Please help with your child's maths by writing and ordering the numbers to 50, learning their number bonds to 10 and adding and subtracting within 50.
