Welcome back

Dear Year 1 Parents and Carers,

Welcome back and we all hope you had a lovely Easter holiday! We are looking forward to another busy and exciting term with lots of interesting learning opportunities. The children are settling back in after the holidays really well and are enjoying being back in school.

<u>Curriculum</u>

<u>Maths</u>

In maths, we will be investigating place value to 100, fractions of numbers and shapes. We will investigate money, telling the time and days of the week and months.

Help your child at home by wearing a watch and practising telling the time on an analogue clock or watch. You can also have fun using money to help your child understand the value of coins.

<u>English</u>

In English, we will be covering a range of non-fiction, fiction and poetry, relating to our topics. We will read and write about such stories as 'A New Home for a Pirate' by Ronda Armitage and Holly Swain, 'Captain Teachum's Buried Treasure' by Peter Carter, 'Beegu' by Alexis Deacon and 'The Way Back Home' by Oliver Jeffers. We will use different materials, skills and techniques to create 'seascapes' and use objects to print with in art.

<u>Science</u>

In science, we will be learning about materials and their properties and planting and observing seed growth.

Humanities (History & Geography)

Our first topic will be Land Ahoy, where we will explore pirate life. We will investigate the lives of famous pirates, their ships and make treasure maps, using compass points, and treasure islands. We will also investigate the coastlines pirates might have explored. Our second topic will be Moon Zoom, where we will learn about famous astronauts and find out more about space travel and space itself.

Enrichment (Art, Music & PE)

In music, we will be exploring music from different composers and composing using instruments. In PE, we will be working together on team games, cricket and tennis.

Religious Education

We will investigate the stories of Noah and Moses and also the Lord's Prayer.

<u>Homework</u>

Please support your child's learning at home by reading with them daily and practising their phonic sounds and high frequency words. Also, you can help improve your child's writing by writing their own sentences, creating stories or shopping lists. Please help with your child's maths by writing and ordering the numbers to 50, learning their number bonds to 10 and adding and subtracting within 50.
