Dear Parents

School Trip Church Lane – Whipsnade Safari Park + Rectory Gardens - Broadstairs

On **Tuesday 27th June** the whole school will be going on a trip. This year it has been decided that this will be split into two events.

Church Lane will be visiting Whipsnade Safari Park. We will be travelling by coach leaving at **9.15am** and we will be back at school by **3.30pm**.

Clothing for Whipsnade:

Your child will need to wear school uniform but can wear trainers instead of their school shoes as there will be a lot of walking. If it is a wet day, they will need a raincoat and if it is hot, please provide a hat. Sun cream will need to be applied at home.

Rectory Gardens will be visiting the seaside at Broadstairs. We will also be travelling by coach leaving at **9.00am** and we aim to be back at school by **5.15pm**.

Clothing for Broadstairs:

Your child does not need to wear school uniform but will need to wear comfortable clothing such as jogging bottoms, a sweatshirt and trainers. Please also provide your child with suitable beach wear which can include shorts, T-shirt, a swimming costume and sandals. It is advisable that you provide a spare pair of clothing (including underwear in the event of these getting wet). Your child will also need a towel. There are changing facilities at the beach. If it is a wet day, they will also need a rain coat and if it is hot, please provide a hat. Sun cream will need to be applied at home and children will be able to apply more of this to themselves once at the beach.

Food & Drink

For both trips, every child will need to bring a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks/nuts/yoghurts), in a back pack. Only cartons of drinks or plastic bottles. Please make sure they have water.

The PSA has contributed a large amount of money towards the trips which has enabled the school to reduce the cost per child. The cost will therefore be **£10.00 per child** which covers the entrance, the cost of the coaches and insurance. No extra spending money is needed.

The cost per child before the PSA support would be £21.50 so if you feel you are able to pay more it would be extremely appreciated. The trip is available to pay either £10 or £21.50 on SchoolMoney.
