Our classrooms provide a calm and peaceful environment where all develop their religious literacy and a relationship with God together, as a family. We include meditation and prayer to still the mind and body so our children can focus on their thoughts and feelings. We dim the lights to allow our children to find a sense of calm and peace and connect with God. We use a calm teaching approach and speaking voice which allows our children to feel safe so enabling them to share their thoughts openly. We discuss and reflect on stories of awe and wonder so developing our relationship with God and His world. We provide our children with creativity in our teaching and learning by using Godly Play, art, dance and music to support and enhance our learning. We participate in trips to places of worship so our children can experience the spirituality in the beauty they see there. We reflect on our learning after each lesson so our children share their views and ideas and feel that they have flourished and achieved.
