Curriculum

Home Learning

The children will have a phonics decodable book and library book sent home on a **Friday**. Please read the phonics decodable book with your child every day and enjoy reading the library book together. Please return these on a **Wednesday** with their reading record. Also, the children will have a login for Numbots so they can enjoy playing maths games online whenever they have access to a device. If any of the children require further phonics help or high frequency word help, then these will be sent home as additional work.

Specialist Teachers

Your child's specialist PE sessions are every **Thursday**. Please make sure children come into school wearing their PE kit. This consists of a plain house coloured t-shirt, black shorts or leggings/tracksuit bottoms and black trainers. In the Winter, please ensure they have a black fleece or sweatshirt. Class Teacher PE will be every **Tuesday** for which they only need to wear trainers.

Children will also have specialist music, art and French sessions timetabled throughout the year.

Punctuality & Attendance

It is really important that your child arrives at school promptly every day to help them settle in to their learning routines. It is also important to be collected promptly.
