# **Happy New Year**

## Curriculum

### **Home Learning**

Homework will be sent home weekly on a Friday in the children's homework books. The expectation is to complete the work and hand it back in on the following Wednesday. This will always contain a list of spellings to be learned as well as times tables to be practised along with an accompanying task relevant to our class learning.

Please remember to use your *Times Table Rock Stars* account or other websites such as Hit the Button to focus on fluency skills (please email the School Office if you cannot find your login). Furthermore, the children also have access to *Spelling Shed* to practise their spelling patterns.

Please ensure that your child reads every day and do listen to them and ask them about **what** they have read. The most important thing is that this is an enjoyable and valuable experience which will further support your child to develop a love of reading.

Please talk to your child about our *Reading Challenge* and which books they have read so far.

### **Specialist Teachers**

Your child's specialist music and French sessions will happen every Tuesday, and PE with Mr Oakley on Mondays. Children to wear their correct PE kit to school - this is a plain house coloured t-shirt, black shorts or leggings/tracksuit bottoms and black trainers. Black fleece/sweatshirt for the winter. PE with class teachers is every Tuesday.

Specialist sessions with Ms Lincoln in art will continue. These will be timetabled throughout the year and will continue on Fridays in the first half of the spring term.

### Punctuality & Attendance

It is really important that your child arrives at school promptly every day to help them settle in to their learning routines. It is also important to be collected promptly.
