#### PE Kit

Children are to wear their correct PE kit to school on their PE days with Mr Oakley - this is a plain house coloured t-shirt, black shorts or leggings/tracksuit bottoms and black trainers. Black fleece/sweatshirt for the winter.

#### Home Learning

Reading books: reading at home is so important to further develop your child's love of reading. We will issue a new reading book every Friday. Please return on Wednesday. Children will bring home a levelled book based on the level they are reading in school. They will also be able to choose a free choice from the Class Library. We expect the children to read for at least 15 minutes at home daily. Please comment in their reading record books so that we know that the children have read at home.

Spelling practice: the children must practice their spelling words that are supplied in their books at home. Spelling tests are on Fridays.

Mathematics homework: Maths is occasionally provided in the homework books, though tasks are set weekly on 'my maths' which you can hopefully access at home. Login details have been provided in homework books last term.

English homework is always provided in homework books to assist children's learning of grammar, punctuation and sentence writing.

Any additional practice you can do at home with your children will always benefit them at school. Particularly as we begin money and multiplication this half term, practice at home will be crucial in helping them get the most out of their learning at school. Thank you in advance!
