#### Hints for parents

The days are getting warmer. Could you please help teach them when they are hot to take off their jumper or jacket and to drink water.

When you are walking around with your children, try and talk about what they can see and hear around them. Can they use any description words? Can they count how many things they can see? This will help with all areas of their development.

#### Trips

Nursery will be visiting Railway Fields before half term and going on a local excursion before the summer holidays.

#### PE Kit

Please make sure on Fridays that children are wearing suitable clothing for PE including trainers and clothes they can move easily around in.

#### Reading at Home

We hope your children are enjoying looking at books at home. Bedtime can be a very special time to share books as they snuggle down into bed.

If you speak a different language at home, please make sure you share books in your home language as well as English and tell the stories that meant a lot to you as you grew up.

When you have a book from school, you can first take time to look at the pictures. What can they see? What do they think the story is going to be about? Then as you read the book maybe they can guess what is going to happen next. Some books will really be enjoyable to your child - don't worry if they want to have it again and again!

Please remember to bring the library books back every week so they can get to choose new books.
