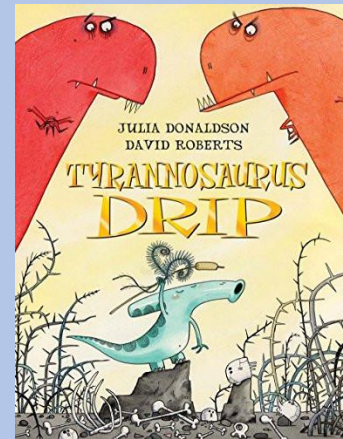
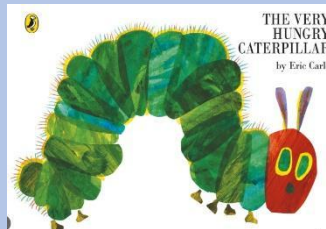
## Expressive Arts & Design
